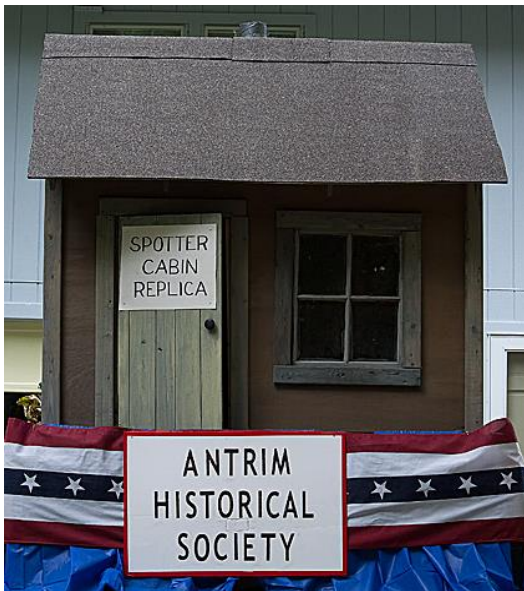

Antrim Historical Society Wins Best Float at Home & Harvest Festival

“Plane Spotting during World War II”

A huge thank you to Liz Robertson and Roy MacDonald for their prize-winning work on the Society parade float depicting Antrim's volunteer airplane spotters during World War II.

From Parades and Promenades:

“In addition to air raid wardens, there were many volunteers, some of whom put in long hours as airplane spotters. The first spotting post, established in 1942, was in the field above G.H.Caughey's . . . under the sponsorship of the American Legion. Initially Mr. Caughey's telephone was used through a window in his house, but eventually a shelter was built, containing its own phone and a wood stove for warmth. History does not record the sighting of any enemy planes, but one night the spotters were treated to the spectacle of a lovely double rainbow.”
